

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION VIA U.S. MAIL

The application must be completed in full, even though the résumé contains similar information. References from Republican and Community Sponsors should be submitted with the application, not sent separately. Incomplete applications will be returned for resubmission by the deadline.

Applications must postmarked by June 30. Applicants who elect to submit their applications via U.S. mail should be sure to submit their Republican and Community Sponsor References with the application, not separately.

The Selection Committee respectfully requests that you do not include materials other than those requested herein. Should additional references be required, you will be contacted and asked to submit those. All information submitted in the application is confidential, as is the fact that an individual has submitted an application.

If chosen as a finalist, a candidate must be available to present herself for a personal interview at a location to be determined by the Selection Committee. Interviews will be scheduled to occur in late July or early August.

The Selection Committee reserves the right to choose program participants based on its own selection criteria, but primary weight will be given to an applicant's commitment to public/political service. The Selection Committee is most interested in those candidates who the Committee feels will be most likely to utilize their leadership skills and political training in New Hampshire. Applicants must be registered to vote as Republicans.

Notification of acceptance to the program will be given in August. The program commences each year in September and ends in the following June. There is a three day trip to Washington, DC in the spring, frequently in May. There must be no conflict between the candidate's employment (if applicable) and the required attendance for the Series. If selected, applicants will be asked to provide a high quality digital photograph for publicity purposes.

The program provides funding for each woman selected for the Series to cover the costs of participants' overnight accommodations in Washington DC, food, and program materials. Participants are responsible for a registration fee of \$250 at the time of their acceptance, as well as their travel costs to all training sessions throughout the program, including the Washington, DC session. Please note there is some limited scholarship assistance available. Please submit a written request for scholarship assistance and return with the application by June 30. All requests are kept confidential.
